DHA informed us that setting up the Advisory Committee had been disrupted by managing the readjustments to the AMEP necessitated by the lock-down but the Committee was expected it to be in place in two-three months.

It was agreed that DHA would give careful consideration to the proposals and supporting information in the Briefing Paper, and that positive engagement between DHA and ACTA would continue.
